LEVELS OF GROUP INVOLVEMENT

Our Mission Field

Represents teenage population within our sphere of influence: local high school campuses, friends of our students, those in our church not currently connected to "The Highway", etc...

Come Level

A student's only commitment to the group is to come, however infrequent, for one reason or another. Some are unchurched teens who are attracted to "fun" activities, trips and events. Others are "Sunday morning" kids who only attend our group because their parents insist.

Grow Level

These students are the ones within our group who are willing to attend and submit themselves to spiritual growth. These are the teens who take part in a youth activity or program, even if it involves them in some amount of Bible study, spiritual discussion or singing. Students at the "grow level" are not necessarily seeking spiritual growth on their own (outside of our youth meetings). They participate because they enjoy it and it requires little more than their passive involvement.

Disciple Level

These students are beginning to take personal initiative and responsibility for their own spiritual growth. These students are doing their own personal devotions, memorizing Scripture, sharing their faith, learning to serve God, seeking to live a holy life, etc...

Leadership Level

These students are growing as disciples and are now interested in being trained and equipped for group leadership and ministry opportunities. Assisting in the implementation of the youth program, sharing in the spiritual responsibilities of the ministry and ministering to others are all appropriate levels of involvement.

Multiplier Level

Those students who are multiplying their spiritual efforts: i.e. - seeing others come to Christ and actively involved in Christian ministry, service and discipleship.
