Sunday Morning "Tune-Up" 8:30 - 9:40, High School room

Each Sunday we gather as a large group for worship with our "Highway Band" and biblical teaching from Jim. We also throw-in a fun crowd breaker, video and music to keep things lively. On occasion, students will connect with their small groups. Encourage students to bring their Bibles!

Sunday Morning Contemporary Service 10:00 - 11:00am, Sanctuary

In high school, we encourage our students to get in the habit of attending a worship service to help them integrate with the larger life and fellowship of our church. We all sit together up front! If possible, please encourage your teen to join us!

Tuesday Nights: "The Highway" 7:00 - 8:45, High School room

Our mid-week gathering helps build community as we discuss relevant issues teens deal with on a daily basis. Topics like friendship, family, peer pressure, substance abuse, entertainment, emotions, acceptance, etc...give you an idea of the discussions we have. We use a variety of "creative communication" tools to make our times interesting, fun and meaningful. We also have a game, worship with our "Highway Band" and small group time for interpersonal connection discussion and prayer.

Small Groups (1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hr. in length) Meet throughout the week in homes/church

Groups are divided by grade and gender, usually consisting of 6-15 in attendance. Small groups provide a relational approach to discipleship where encouragement, trust and accountability are shared. Small group gatherings are organized around a time of personal sharing, prayer and study. Small group leaders choose their curriculum based on the students particular needs in coordination with the high school pastor.
